# Here's What You'll Need Kid

- A lathe and some wood (I mean that kinda goes without sayin)
- Thin CA
- Medium CA
- CA Activator
- Paper Towels
- Rubber Gloves
- A rag you don't care about
- 3 Stage Plastic Polish (or a plastic polish of your choice, you decide I'm not your father)
- Safety glasses and a respirator (not really necessary but it really does help)
- 9 stage micromesh pads
- 400 and 600 grit sandpaper
- A cup of water
- A can do attitude and good spirits! (blast some toons of your choice)



# Why Choose CA

- Virtually maintenance free
- Durable, and can withstand constant handling
- A glassy glossy finish
- Clear and waterproof
- It will protect the project you love so dear



# Here's What You Gotta Do To Start

- Put on something to cover your clothes
- Place the rag on the bed of your lathe
- If using a pen mandrel place your blanks between non-stick bushings
- Put on some rubber gloves (word of warning)
- Fold up some paper towels
- Apply one layer of thin CA and let dry naturally
- Apply two more layers lightly spraying with accelerator in between applications
- Apply four layers of medium CA using activator in between layers
- If using pen mandrel remove blanks from non-stick bushings (don't worry about the hangoff)



# Now That The Fun Stuff Is Over, Let's Wrap Up

- Time to Start using the micromesh
- Once done polish that bad boy up
- Sit back, relax, you're all done
- Congrats!!!
