CHALLENGE

The June challenge was **Kitchen Tools**

We had no entrants in the Beginner category, and only one in the Intermediate (who was bumped up), so only one winner was selected, which was **Kim Acuna** for her salt & pepper shakers made from plum with Waterlox finish.



She had also entered a toothpick holder made from “woodpile surprise”, finished with Waterlox, while **Jim Schopper** presented a salad bowl for two (wedding gift) made of walnut, finished with Mahoney’s walnut oil & wax.



John Janssen had a couple of rolling pins and a salt and pepper set; woods were ash, maple & Chinese elm, mineral oil finish.



In the spatula category, we had one by **Jeff Slezar** of maple, walnut & purpleheart finished with butcher block oil, while **Bill Haskell** gave us a curved one of hard maple finished with almond oil.



Carey Caires had a (visible to the naked eye, no less!) pie/cake server fashioned from box elder burl and laminated wood finished with walnut oil and Mahony wax.



Judges were **Craig Sobel**, **Henry Koch**, and **Joanie Cole**.

SHOW AND TELL

We had a nice variety of things from various people:

Bill Loitz had his 48" tall off-center goblet made of maple & poplar, finished with friction polish. (He had also shown this at the Portland Symposium)



Tony Thiessen had been quite busy making bowls: materials were ash, spalted something, maple, and curly maple. All finished with beeswax/carnuba/walnut oil.



Rick Silverstein presented some box elder bowls, finishes were polyurethane and danish oil.



Kim Acuna also had bowls - oak and box elder (?) finished with Waterlox.



Bob Clark had a Beads of Courage box of jatobe & Spectraply finished with Minwax, and **Henry Koch** a hollow form of melaluca with Modern Masters paint & Deft sanding sealer.



Bill Haskell had another of his tall bottle forms, this one made of mesquite, finished with lacquer.



John Janssen had some pine toy cars & planes, finished with butcher block oil



Ron Shaffer had a closed segment bowl of maple, padauk, cherry & wenge finished with Arm-R-Seal.
